What type of programs/childcare does Head Start/Pre-K offer?

Our programs are designed to offer a wide-variety of experiences within a safe environment that encourage individuality and stimulate the growth of the whole child.

Child-initiated activities and hands-on learning experiences are the fundamental elements within our curriculum. Weekly thematic units provide a variety of new ideas and activities so that each child is exposed to the world around them.

It is our philosophy that each child should learn at their own pace by participating in age-appropriate activities that enable each child to discover their potential.

What is Head Start?

Head Start is a Federal program for preschool children from low-income families. The Head Start program is operated by local non-profit organizations in almost every county in the country. Children who attend Head Start participate in a variety of education activities. They also receive free medical and dental care, have healthy meals and snacks, and enjoy playing indoors and outdoors in a safe setting.

What is Pre-K?

Pre-K comprehensive child care program offers enrollment opportunities to families whose income is above the federal poverty guidelines on a sliding scale fee.
